

HOW TO GET SERVICES

Please call (517) 546-4126 and say you want to schedule an Intake Appointment for the Parent Infant Program.

The first appointment is called an Initial Assessment or Initial Intake and this is done in the Intake office at CMH located at 2280 E Grand River, Howell, MI.

After that, your appointments are generally in your home but can take place in the office or community.

PARENT INFANT PROGRAM OFFERS:

- **Weekly Home-Based Services to provide parents and infants/toddlers with:**
 - Parental Support
 - Counseling
 - Psychotherapy
 - Developmental Guidance
 - Information on other community resources and programs
 - Support in the development of a healthy relationship between parents and their infants/toddlers



PARENT INFANT PROGRAM SERVES:

- Residents of Livingston County
- Individuals with Medicaid or income eligible
- Pregnant women or parents/primary caregivers with infants/toddlers between the ages of 0-3 years
- Parents experiencing a difficult pregnancy, labor and delivery, postpartum depression, or adjustment to parenthood
- Infants experiencing low birth weight, eating/ sleeping difficulties, and delays in developmental milestones
- Infants and toddlers with emotional, physical, or behavioral concerns
- Parents and infants/toddlers who have experienced trauma or loss

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Staff are Master's level clinical social workers with specialized training in parent and infant/toddler relationships
- Staff will come to your home for weekly sessions
- Sessions will focus on the relationship between parents and their infants/toddlers
- Services may be covered by Medicaid. Sliding fee scales are calculated by family income and size. If you qualify for Medicaid, you may not be charged any fee. This will be discussed at your first appointment.
